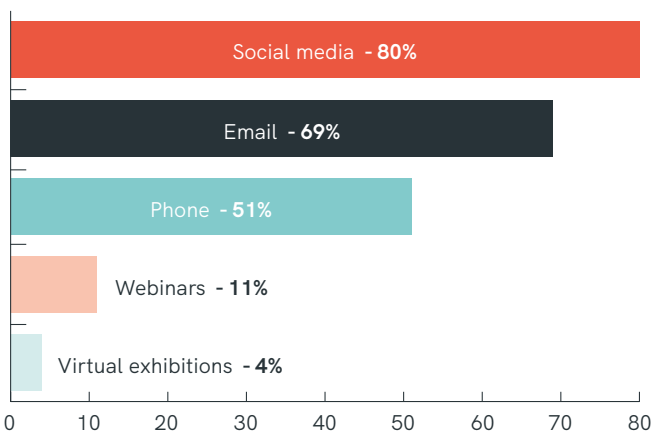


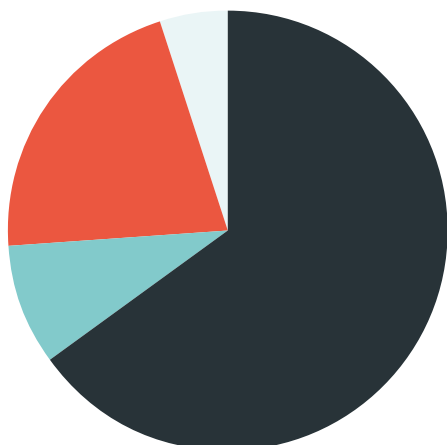
Planning during COVID-19 Councillors Study

Methodology: BECG commissioned Savanta ComRes who interviewed 429 UK Councillors from 8th to 14th April 2020. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of UK Councillors. Savanta ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.

Q1. Which of the following methods, if any, is your local authority currently using to engage with residents during the COVID-19 pandemic?*

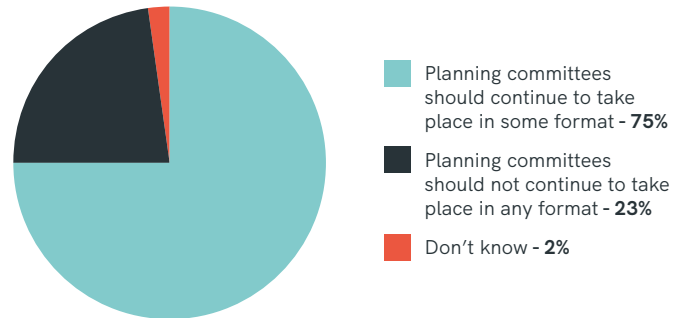

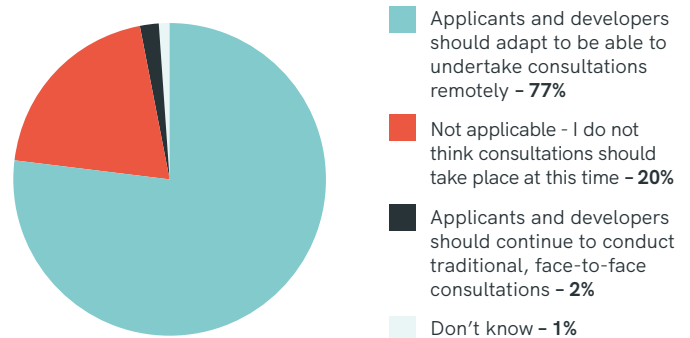


Negative economic impact - 65% (net)

 Don't know - 5%

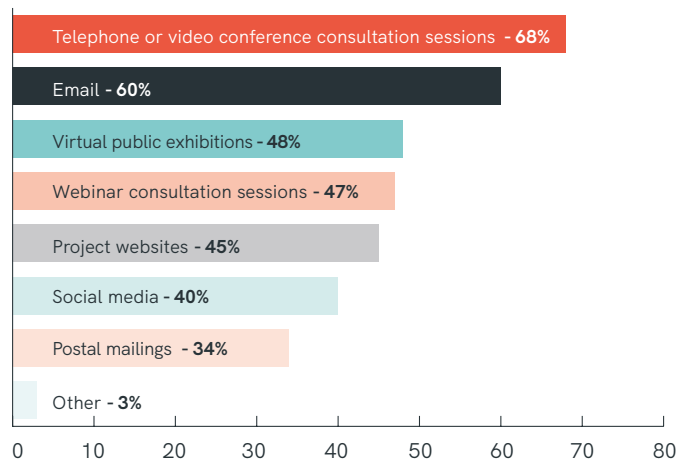
Q3. Which of the following statements best describes your view on determining planning applications during the COVID-19 pandemic?*
